HIGH POINT AWARDS

Award Divisions

- Walk/Trot - 18 & Under
- Walk/Trot - 19 & Over
- Junior Rider, 13 & Under
- Junior Rider, 14 - 18
- Adult Amateur - 19 & Over

Rules

- Exhibitor will select which high point award they are competing for at the first show they attend.
- Walk/Trot riders may not cross-enter into canter/lope classes.
- Riders who select canter/lope classes may enter walk/trot classes only to school a horse and will not be placed by the judge.
- Exhibitor must show in at least 5 out of 8 of the shows to be eligible for the overall high point.
- If an Adult Amateur - 19 & Over enters an open class, the points will count towards the amateur high point.
- Youth riders (18 and under) may not ride in open classes specified for 19 & over
- In-hand classes count toward chosen high point division.
- Points are earned by the rider on all horses being shown.
- Points are calculated on the number of entries in a class. Depending on the number of entries in a class, 6 is the maximum number of points a person can earn. For example, in a class of 6 or more horses:
 - 1 = 6 points
 - 2 = 5 points
 - 3 = 4 points
 - 4 = 3 points
 - 5 = 2 points
 - 6 = 1 point

Awards

- Individual Show High Point - Champion & Reserve Champion will be awarded at each of the shows in the 5 award divisions
- Overall High Point Champion and Reserve will be awarded a prize in each of the 5 divisions at the conclusion of the show circuit.
- SAAHA Arabian Horse High Point
 - o Exhibitor must be a current member of SAAHA
 - o Horses must be a registered Arabian or Half-Arabian
 - o Points will be awarded for all classes shown during show circuit as outlined in the Rules
- Youth Equitation High Point Champion
- Trail High Point Champion

Class Fees:

- \$10 - SAAHA/H Members
- \$12 - Non-members

Office Fee:

- \$10 per horse

Stall or Haul-In Fee: (each entry must pay one)

- \$30 (includes one bag of shavings)
- \$10 Grounds fee
- \$10 Extra bag of shavings (optional)

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Show Committee and/or judge(s) reserves the right to excuse any exhibitor and/or horse showing unsafe behavior, lameness, unsportsmanlike conduct toward other horses, exhibitors or show staff.
2. As closely as possible, USEF rules will be in effect; a rulebook is kept in the office.
3. Martingales will be allowed in all classes.
4. Draw reins are allowed only in novice horse classes.
5. Tie-downs, mechanical hackamores, or any other illegal equipment is **NOT** allowed in any class. If you are unsure about your equipment, please consult the show office.
6. Stallions may be shown (see rule 1).
7. Definitions:
 - a. **WALK/TROT** – Riders not entered into lope/canter/gallop classes except to school, which does not count toward WT high point
 - b. **NOVICE HORSE** – Has not won more than 3 blue ribbons in that performance division
 - c. **AGE DIVISIONS** – Based on age as of January 1
8. **Hats and boots are required.**
9. Proper show attire is recommended.
10. **Helmets are required in leadline classes, but may be worn in any class.**
11. **Leadline** riders must have their feet in stirrups. Additionally, the lead may **NOT** be attached to the bit.
12. **Classes may be combined, split or canceled.**
13. Riders with open checks can add classes at the gate. All other entries must be made at least 2 classes in advance at the show office.
14. **All entries taken on the show ground or by computer. Open checks preferred; credit cards accepted.**
15. Office opens one hour before the show begins.
16. Scratched classes must be taken at the show office.
17. Refunds given at the discretion of show management.
18. No alcoholic beverages on show premises.
19. All exhibitors must be off show grounds ½ hour after completion of show.

Stalls available for \$30.00 (includes 1 bag of shavings)**

**Note: Trail may not be available at all shows. Check with the show office or see our email one week before each show---
Trail will close around 4 pm**

We reserve the right to combine or split classes as needed. If a split is desired, please inform the office when signing in. For example, if 2 kids in same division need to ride the same horse.
